

THE HORNET FUN FANTASY LEAGUE

Compete against family, friends & other football fans at no cost and with just one email...

Every season THE HORNET, Watford FC's official matchday programme, offers supporters the chance to enter a unique Fantasy League.

There is no need to spend time each week anticipating who Manchester City will have in their team, or if Gabriel Jesus will be fit to play. Just pick eight teams at the start of the season, then relax and track your entry via THE HORNET!

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Each of the 92 League clubs is allocated a points value, broadly based on bookmaker's pre-season odds. These are shown on the page opposite. The more fancied the team, the higher its value and vice-versa.

You must select two teams from each of the four divisions, with those eight teams having a combined value of 24 points or less.

Then, during the season, to work out your score, we simply add together the league points of your teams, plus or minus their goal difference. So, for example, last season Watford won 63 points and had a +3 goal difference, which meant they had a final score of 66.

So, do you think Arsenal can push on from last season? Will Everton, under Sean Dyche, struggle again? Can Leeds, Leicester or Southampton bounce straight back to the Premier League, or will all their departures

badly affect them? Can Wrexham and Notts County get promoted straight out of League Two? Decide on how best to spread your 24 points, send in an e-mail, then sit back and enjoy the ride.

STEP BY STEP GUIDE TO ENTERING

- Choose your eight teams (two from each 'division') and make sure their scores do not add up to more than 24.
- E-mail your entry to programme@watfordfc.com, making sure you put the words 'Fantasy League' in the subject line. If you do not use e-mail, ask a friend or family member to do it for you. Entries can only be accepted by e-mail. Include in your e-mail the following information:
 - Name
 - Home Postal address, or town.
 - Contact e-mail address
 - Contact telephone number
 - Provide your date of birth. If under 18, please include an adult contact name and number.
- Ensure your entries are received by no later than midnight on September 10, 2023, so you have a few weeks to judge how teams start the



season and until after the closure of the transfer window to enter.

- One entry per person, but why not encourage your family and friends to enter, so you can compete against each other? Multiple entries for different people from one family member or friend, will be accepted, as long as we have information as above for each entrant.
- The details of how to enter will be featured in the first three programmes of the season and also on-line, so you will have

plenty of time to enter, even if unable to attend games during August.

None of the information provided will be used for any purpose, other than possibly contacting you to feature in the programme during the season. We will feature a different person or family in THE HORNET for each home game.

There is a trophy for the highest score at the end of the season (see picture), possible other prizes, plus the honour of being the 2023/24 Champion!
