The successful candidate will work as part of a multi-disciplinary support team, providing video analysis and IT support to all academy staff and players.

Duties will involve, filming of all academy games and training sessions, providing analysis of players and teams across all age groups as guided by coaching staff. Preparation of video feedback for use at team de-briefing meetings and individual player meetings and to support academy management with collation of statistics relating to the academy productivity targets and KPI's.

The role will be based at the clubs training ground in London Colney and will include working across all Academy ages, (U9's to U23).

The successful candidate will enjoy working as part of a team, be enthusiastic and hardworking, and be flexible to the requirements of the position.
